JOB DESCRIPTION

I. Position Summary:

The Manager will be responsible to develop the reporting systems, key metrics, and dashboards required to effectively manage all materials planning aspects of the business while working across the organization with peers in Engineering, Kitting, Scheduling, Purchasing, Operations, Maintenance, Finance, and Accounting.

II. Essential Functions:

Lead Material Planning Team by:

- Partner with IT/SAP to develop the required reporting that allows the team to quickly and accurately produce usable reports which allow the team to analyze the data, identify issues/opportunities, and take measurable action.
- Develop and manage key metrics in support of business objectives and tactical targets including supply demand forecasting, on time delivery, materials sparing levels, minimum / maximum stocking levels, etc
- Strong engagement within the larger Supply Chain Team (Kitting, Purchasing, Materials, Scheduling, Line Replaceable Unit Repair) to ensure understanding of business needs and lead process improvement efforts to optimize the flow of material through the supply chain
- Identify material supply risks based upon master schedule and MRP (Material Requirement Planning) inputs and develop / execute mitigation plans for those risks
- Active participation on numerous cross functional teams
- Support Accounting requirements for inventory reporting and data
- Other duties as assigned by management

III. Interactions:

Supervision Received:

- Plans, designs, and carries out programs, projects, studies, or other work independently. Receives little or no supervision from Team leader

Supervisory Duties:

- Trains, assigns work to, and checks work of two (2) or more Team members; participates in the decision to hire, fire, and promote Team members; does not conduct the same work as Team members on a regular basis. Also leads integrated cross functional efforts.
